The New York State Grown & Certified program makes it easy for consumers to identify local, safely handled, and environmentally responsible agricultural products. This voluntary program is a cooperative effort among producers, processors, wholesalers, retailers, restaurants, and the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets to meet consumer demand for high-quality food and agricultural products.

Maple producers are eligible to participate in New York State Grown & Certified if they adhere to best practices in safe food handling and operate in an environmentally responsible manner as described in the Program Requirements. Upon acceptance to the New York State Grown & Certified program and submission of a signed trademark licensing agreement, program participants will be able to display a new high-impact label that will clearly stand out and tell the consuming public their food handling practices are audited and certified and that they operate their farms in an environmentally responsible manner.

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- **Applicability:** 100% of maple syrup is sourced from New York maple trees and processed in New York State. When syrup of a desired grade is not available as required, up to 25% may be sourced from out-of-state.
- **Safe Food Handling:** Certificate of completion of Maple Food Safety Class and compliance with food safety best practices subject to onsite audit.
- **Environmental Stewardship:** Producer participates in one of the following environmental management programs, or equivalent:
  - New York State Agricultural Environmental Management (AEM) program, administered by the Department of Agriculture and Markets, with the completion of Tier 2 of the program (or higher) within three years of admission into the New York State Grown & Certified program;
  - Group Certified Tree Farmer, administered by the American Tree Farm System; or
  - Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Forest Management Certification
